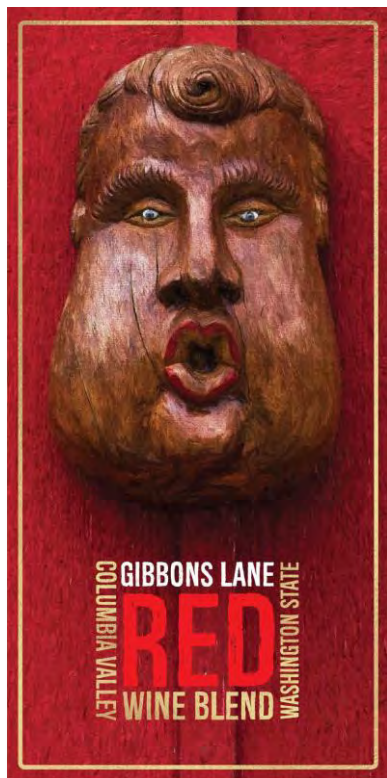
The grapes for this non-vintage wine were hand-picked from source vineyards in Rattlesnake Hills and Red Mountain from the 2015 and 2016 harvests, sorted and gently crushed - we are 100% free run, which means we do not press (very unusual) to enhance concentration and color intensity and then ferment in small lots using proprietary yeasts.

The fanciful, hand carved mask on our label came from Mexico (smuggled in a golf bag) more than a dozen years ago. The face reminded me of a beloved longtime mentor, so we named him 'BIG BOB' in his honor. We found the perfect location for 'BIG BOB' high on the outside of the cellar where he looks out over the winery and vineyard and keeps us all smiling — the red lips were my idea at his christening (it's real lipstick)!

Enjoy the big cherry notes, full body and spicy backbone of this wine with a variety of dishes from grilled herb-rubbed flat-iron steak to pappardelle with sausage ragù, Memphis-Style Barbecued Spareribs or Carne Asada.

Our team takes great pride in what we do and we hope it shows in every glass. Cheers!
